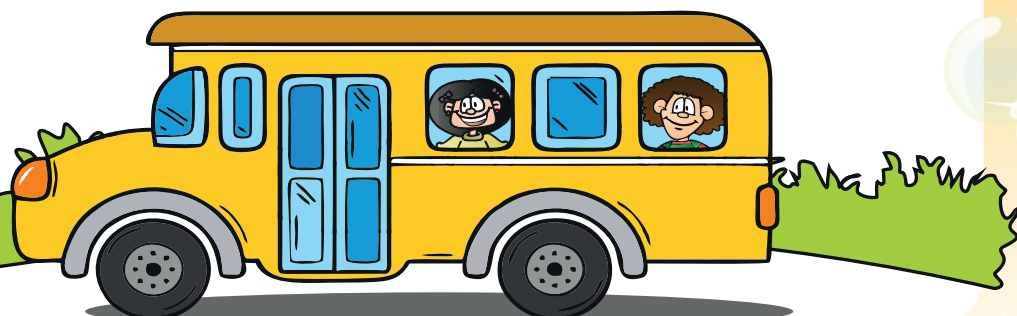
## 6 | YUMMY, DELICIOUS!
